

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed with Syracuse City, Utah, to annex 1.944 acres of property located at approximately 2761 S. 3000 W., and more particularly described as follows:

“A part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Beginning at a point on the west line of said northwest quarter being located south 00°32'03" west 392.00 feet along said west line from the northwest corner of said Section 21; running thence south 89°27'57" east 33.00 feet to the east right-of-way line of 3000 West street; thence along said east right-of-way line north 00°32'03" east 100.00 feet; thence south 89°27'57" east 407.00 feet; thence south 00°32'03" west 200.00 feet; thence north 89°27'57" west 440.00 feet to the west line of said northwest quarter; thence along the west line of said northwest quarter north 00°32'03" east 100.00 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 1.944 acres.”

Petition was certified by the Syracuse City Recorder and notice of certification received by the Syracuse City Council on April 27, 2023. A copy of the complete annexation petition is available for inspection and copying at Syracuse City Office, 1979 West 1900 South, Syracuse, UT 84075, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except holidays.

Syracuse City may grant the petition and annex the area described in the petition unless, within 30 days after the date of the City Council receipt of the notice of certification, a written protest to the annexation petition is filed with the Davis County Boundary Commission, P.O. Box 618, Farmington, Utah, 84025, and a copy of the protest delivered to the Syracuse City Recorder. The protest period will end June 1, 2023. Written protests may be filed by the legislative body or governing board of an affected entity with the Davis County Boundary Commission between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays.
